GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR MID TERM EXAMS

Please read the instructions carefully and follow the same for the successful execution of the Mid Term Examinations, 2020.

- The Mid Term Exams will be held from 12th Sept. to the 29th Sept., 2020. Due to
 the extra ordinary circumstances prevalent in the country, a gap of 2 to 3 days are
 being given so that students are not subjected to any unnecessary pressure.
- 50% of the paper will be subjective in nature. Hence the question paper must be made in Google Form. Students will be asked to join in Google Classroom.
- 3. 50% of the question paper will be in the form of MCQs. Teachers will, therefore, only need to evaluate the subjective part of the question paper. The subjective part of the answer scripts will be attempted by the students on A-4 size sheets and submitted in the form of PDF.
- Pictures, diagrams and unseen passages can be copy-pasted on the question paper.
- 5. Since teachers have faced a problem of Google Form not accepting more than 100 students at a time, teachers must save the same question paper under two names for eg. English I and English II. English I can then be given to sections A and B while English II can be given to sections C and D.
- 6. The subjective part of the paper will also be typed in Google Form, where the answer will be listed as 'NOT REQUIRED' and weightage of the question will be '0'. The student will merely read the questions and write the answers on A-4 size sheets to be duly uploaded in PDF.
- Students upto class 7 will log in using their parents ID, while from 8th onwards they will use their own IDs.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLASSES 5TH TO 8TH, 11TH & 12TH

- Duration of the paper will be 1½ hrs.
- Timing will be from 10:30 am to 12:00 pm.
- Maximum marks for each subject will be 40.
- Maximum marks for Sanskrit and Computers will be 20.
- 5. In the subjective part there will be 6 questions of two marks each, but there will be choice of 9 questions is students will have to do 6 out of 9 questions.
 - Similarly, there will be 2 questions of 4 marks each, but there will be choice –
 ie students will have to do 2 questions out of 3.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR 9TH AND 10TH

- Since it has already been decided during the result discussion of session 2019-20 that classes 9th & 10th should have exams of 20 marks only, the Mid Term exam of session 2020-21 will be of 20 marks.
- The duration of the exam will be of 1 hour.
- The timings will be from 10:30 am to 11:30 am.
- In the subjective part of the paper of classes 9th and 10th, there will be 3
 questions of 2 marks, but 5 choices will be given, ie. Student will be required to
 attempt any 3 out of 5 questions of 2 marks each.

There will be 1 question of 4 marks but 2 choices will be given, ie. Student will be required to attempt any 1 out of 2 questions of 4 marks.
