CIRCULAR

As per govt. orders dated 14.12.2020, the school will reopen as per the dates given below.

Roadmap for reopening the school.

I Date of return

Students will be booked in on the following dates with gap of 72 hrs for their quarantine.

Class 12 – 1st January, 2021

Class 10 – 5th January, 2021

Class 11 – 8th January, 2021

Class 9 – 11th January, 2021

Reporting time 11:00 am to 2:00 pm. Dinner will be provided by the school.

II Stay of students in hostels

It is to be assumed that 161 girls and 193 boys will be reporting back. All 4 hostels (ie. Jr. Boys, Sr. Boys, Jr. Girls and Sr. Girls hostels) will be used for housing them to maintain social distancing, as given below –

- (i) Class 9 and 10 girls – Jr. Girls Hostel
- (ii) Class 11 and 12 girls – Sr. Girls Hostel
- (iii) Class 9 and 10 Boys – Jr. Boys Hostel
- (iv) Class 11 and 12 Boys – Sr. Boys Hostel

III Meals

Boys will have their meals in the senior mess whereas girls will have their meals in the junior mess.

IV Academics

1. As per govt. directions, only 15 students will be there in each class. School will operate in two shifts, ie. Pre-lunch and post-lunch session. 5 periods of 30 minutes each will be taught in the both the shifts. Boys' classes will be held in 1st shift while girls' classes will be held in the 2nd shift.

2. Supervisory duties (taking rounds to ensure wearing of masks by students, social distancing, any other issue, taking rounds in the mess and hostels) will be done by coaches and KNS teachers. Online classes will be conducted for classes V to VIII. The winter vacation will commence for these classes from 24th December 2020 to 14th January 2021. For classes which are supposed to report in the school as per the given schedule, there will be no online classes and till the time they report in the school they will have their winter vacation.
3. **Games** – There will be no morning games due to severe cold conditions. There will be evening games from 4:00 pm to 5:30 pm. All the students will report to their respective games field during games time.
4. **Early dinner** – Students will have early dinner at 7:30 pm and go back to their hostels for self study.

V **Administrative steps to be taken prior to the arrival of the students.**

Administrative officer has been sent a list of important work to be undertaken before the arrival of the students.

VI **Mandatory directions for students and consent letter to be given by parents.**

Some mandatory directions are being issued to the students keeping in mind the govt. directives and Covid protocol. A letter of consent has been drafted in both Hindi and English for the parents to sign. Parents will have to read the mandatory directives carefully and then sign. the consent letter. Parents are also requested to guide their wards to follow all necessary Covid 19 protocol.

Students must report in the school on the day mentioned in the schedule. **NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO JOIN SCHOOL ON ANY OTHER DATE DUE TO THE MANDATORY COVID QUARANTINE PERIOD OF 72 HRS.**

COVID PROTOCOL – MANDATORY DIRECTIONS FOR STUDENTS & PARENTS

The govt. has permitted the reopening of residential schools with some mandatory directives to be followed by the school. They are –

1. Student reporting back to school must come with Covid 19 test (RTPCR) conducted not more than 72 hrs earlier than the reporting date. Covid test can be undertaken at any govt. health centre, hospital or by any recognized private laboratory with the result provided in a printed report. Student must report on the dates mentioned in the schedule with their parents. **NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED UNESCORTED**, including senior boys.
2. Any student who has symptoms like dry cough, fever, loss of smell etc. must report in the school only after recovering completely.
3. Student reporting back must come with the following items –
 - (i) Washable cloth face masks – 6 nos. with student's name and school no. written in the front left corner with indelible ink. (permanent marker)
 - (ii) Hand sanitizers – 2 nos. of 200 ml each.
 - (iii) Adequate number of under garments and towels.
 - (iv) Large hankies/face towels – 6 in nos.
 - (v) Quilt with 2 covers.
4. No mobiles or other electronic devices will be allowed.
5. NO LEAVE will be granted once the student is booked in. No short leave for minor purchases will be allowed, including books, shoes, toiletry items. No leave for attending wedding or related ceremonies, illness of family members etc will be granted.
6. Non essential activities like parties will not take place.
7. **NO PARENTS WILL BE PERMITTED TO MEET THEIR CHILDREN AFTER THEY ARE BOOKED IN.**
8. PTM will be online.
9. In case a student tests positive during his/her stay, he/she will be immediately removed to the Civil Hospital, Sonipat and parents will be informed. Patient will then be handed over to the parents.

10. Students who flout the above rules will not be permitted to stay in the campus and parents will be asked to take them home as they might be potential risk for other students.
11. A consent letter is being sent to parents through whatsapp & website. Students will be permitted to report back to school only with their parents carrying printed covid 19 report and consent letter in the given format only. Parents are required to read the document titled 'Covid Protocol – Mandatory Directions for Students' and sign the consent letter given below.

कोविड-19 के विषय में विद्यार्थियों और अभिभावकों के लिए आवश्यक दिशा-निर्देश:

सरकार द्वारा आवासीय विद्यालयों को खोलने की अनुमति के उपरांत विद्यालय द्वारा निम्नलिखित दिशा निर्देश दिए जाते हैं-

1. प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी को कोविड-19 (RTPCR) टैस्ट 72 घंटे में करवाना अनिवार्य है। विद्यार्थी को सरकारी, सामुदायिक केन्द्र या गैरसरकारी प्रयोगशाला (मान्यता प्राप्त) से प्रिंटेड रिपोर्ट लानी होगी। सभी छात्र उपरोक्त तिथियों के अनुसार ही अपने अभिभावकों के साथ आएंगे। किसी भी छात्र को बिना अभिभावक के आने की अनुमति नहीं है।

2. किसी विद्यार्थी को यदि सूखी खोंसी, बुखार या अन्य लक्षण दिखाई दें तो उसे पूरी तरह ठीक होने के बाद ही रिपोर्ट करना होगा।

3. विद्यार्थियों को निम्नलिखित वस्तुओं के साथ रिपोर्ट करना होगा।

क) वॉशेबल कपड़ों के मास्क: 06

मास्क के बाएँ कोने पर मार्कर से अपना नाम व स्कूल नं० लिखा होना चाहिए।

ख) हैंड सेनिटाइजर - 200 मिली के 02

ग) उचित मात्रा में अंडरगारमेंट्स और तौलिए।

घ) बड़े रूमाल - 06

ड) रजाई एवं 02 रजाई कवर

4. मोबाईल व इलैक्ट्रॉनिक्स सामान स्कूल परिसर में वर्जित है।

5. विद्यार्थी के स्कूल आने के बाद कोई अवकाश नहीं दिया जाएगा और किताबें, जूते और अन्य सामान खरीदने के लिए भी कोई अवकाश नहीं मिलेगा। विवाह और परिजनों की बिमारी पर भी अवकाश नहीं दिया जाएगा।

6. पार्टी और अनावश्यक क्रिया-कलाप भी नहीं होगी।

7. विद्यालय में आने के बाद विद्यार्थी को अपने माता-पिता से मिलने की अनुमति नहीं दी जाएगी।

8. पेरेटस-टीचर मीटिंग भी ऑनलाइन होगी।

9. यदि किसी विद्यार्थी को यहाँ रहते हुए कोरोना पॉजीटिव पाया जाता है तो उसे तुरन्त सिविल अस्पताल, सोनीपत में ले जाएँगे, और माता-पिता को सूचित करके उसे सौंप दिया जाएगा।

10. यदि परिसर में रहते हुए विद्यार्थी नियमों का पालन नहीं करता है तो उसे पेरेटस के साथ घर भेज दिया जाएगा ताकि अन्य विद्यार्थियों को संक्रमण का खतरा न हो।

11. विद्यालय द्वारा अभिभावकों को सहमति पत्र वॉटसएप एव वैंबसाईट के जरिए भेजा जाएगा और अभिभावकों को अपने बच्चे के साथ वह सहमति पत्र हस्ताक्षर सहित तथा कोविड रिपोर्ट (प्रिटेंड) लाना होगा।
