**CIRCULAR**

**SUB : Reg. Reopening of School.**

1. The Education Directorate, vide circular no. KW3,1-2016ACD(1) reg. Reopening of residential school for students of 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> classes, has recommended the reopening of residential schools.
2. It has therefore been decided that the school will reopen on 25.08.2021, with the following precautions :-
  - (i) Classes 12<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> will report on 25.08.21, while classes 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> will report on 03.09.21. from 2 pm to 5 pm.
  - (ii) Students will report back with a mandatory covid-19 negative RTPCR test conducted not more than 72 hrs before reporting.
  - (iii) Students will be quarantined in 'C' block of boys hostel and junior girls hostel for 3 days after which there will be another RTPCR test. Commensurate to that, classes will begin in right earnest.
  - (iv) Games will also begin as per normal schedule, i.e. in the mornings and evenings.
  - (v) Consent letter will be taken from parents during the time of booking in of students. A copy is being uploaded on the official website and Whatsapp group.
  - (vi) Mandatory directions for the students will be posted on the official website and Whatsapp groups.
3. Online teaching of classes 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> will continue as per the time table.

## COVID PROTOCOL – MANDATORY DIRECTIONS FOR STUDENTS & PARENTS

The govt. has permitted the reopening of residential schools with some mandatory directives to be followed by the school. They are –

1. Student reporting back to school must come with Covid 19 test (RT-PCR) conducted not more than 72 hrs earlier than the reporting date. Covid test can be undertaken at any govt. health centre, hospital or by any recognized private laboratory with the result provided in a **printed report** Parents must ensure that RT-PCR test is conducted in their presence. Student must report on the dates mentioned in the schedule with their parents.  
**NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED UNESCORTED**, including senior boys.
2. Any student who has symptoms like dry cough, fever, loss of smell etc. will not be booked in.
3. Student reporting back must come with the following items –
  - (i) Washable cloth face masks – 6 nos. with student's name and school no. written in the front left corner with indelible ink. (permanent marker)
  - (ii) Hand sanitizers – 2 nos. of 200 ml each.
  - (iii) Adequate number of under garments and towels.
  - (iv) Large hankies/face towels – 6 in nos.
  - (v) ALL OUT mosquito repellent machine and refill bottle.
4. **No mobiles or other electronic devices will be allowed, even for any online coaching.**
5. **NO LEAVE will be granted once the student is booked in. No short leave for minor purchases will be allowed, including books, shoes, toiletry items. No leave for attending wedding or related ceremonies, illness of family members etc will be granted.**
6. Non essential activities like parties will not take place.
7. **NO PARENTS WILL BE PERMITTED TO MEET THEIR CHILDREN AFTER THEY ARE BOOKED IN.**
8. In case a student tests positive during his/her stay, he/she will be immediately removed to the Civil Hospital, Sonipat and parents will be informed. Patient will then be handed over to the parents.
9. Students who flout the above rules will not be permitted to stay in the campus and parents will be asked to take them home as they might be potential risk for other students.

## MANDATORY INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

1. No students will move out of their rooms during first 03 days that is from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
2. Regular classes will start from 28<sup>th</sup> August 2021 onward every day.
3. Wearing mask is mandatory in academic block, hostel and mess.
4. Social distancing will be maintained, wherever you are.
5. Wash your mask daily. You must have an adequate no. of cotton cloth masks marked with your name and school no. as directed earlier.
6. Don't move out of your designated area in the hostel rooms.
7. Carry your own sanitizer in your pocket and use it frequently.
8. Social distancing must be maintained, while using washroom .
9. Don't share or exchange books, notebooks, clothing items etc.
10. Wash your hands frequently with soap.
11. Bring trousers and long sleeved shirts to avoid mosquito bites.
12. Report any case of cough and cold, loss of smell etc. if you see any one, so that necessary action can be taken.
13. Adhere to the instructions given by the school administration.

**Standard Operating Procedures for Health, Hygiene and other safety**  
**protocols for teaching, coaching & hostel staff**

1. Teachers must reach the classroom on time and before the previous teacher leaves the classroom.
2. Students must be asked to remain seated and not approach the teacher without permission.
3. Problems must be addressed from the lectern and solved on the blackboard.
4. Coaches must try to maintain distance even on the field so as not to jeopardize their own health and safety.
5. All teachers, coaches and hostel staff are required to mandatorily wear a good quality mask.
6. All teachers, coaches and hostel staff must wear a face – shield while in class or in the hostel. These have been provided by the school.
7. Teaching, coaching and hostel staff must maintain social distancing among the students in the mess during different meals, during milk break and while supervising the prep.
8. All staff on supervision duty must take a round of the kitchen area to check the hygiene.
9. Teaching staff should avoid checking notebooks of students. They should point out any error in the work done by students verbally.
10. Hand sanitizers must be frequently used in the labs while students are performing practicals. Teachers and students must wear gloves in the laboratories. Each student will be issued a pair of gloves which he/she must carry whenever they go for lab classes.
11. There should be arrangement of soap and running water in the lab. Students should wash their hands frequently.
12. Hostel staff/HMs must ensure that students do not approach the main door of their residence time and again or ring the bell. They must inform the chaukidar/ayah/warder, who will approach the concerned person.
13. All the teaching, coaching and hostel staff are requested to minimize their movements outside for their own safety and that of the student.

## कोविड-19 के सविषय में विद्यार्थियों और अभिभावकों के लिए आवश्यक दिशा-निर्देश

सरकार द्वारा आवासीय विद्यालयों को खोलने की अनुमति के उपरांत विद्यालय द्वारा निम्नलिखित दिशा-निर्देश दिए जाते हैं :-

1. प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी को कोविड-19 (RT-PCR) टैस्ट 72 घंटों में करवाना अनिवार्य है विद्यार्थी को सरकारी, सामुदायिक केन्द्र या गैर सरकारी प्रयोगशाला (मान्यता प्राप्त) से प्रिंटेड रिपोर्ट लानी होगी। अभिभावको से यह अनुरोध है कि (RT-PCR) टैस्ट वह अपने सामने करवाए। सभी छात्र उपरोक्त तिथियों के अनुसार ही अपने अभिभावको के साथ आएंगे। किसी भी छात्र को बिना अभिभावक के आने की अनुमति नहीं है। अभिभावको से यह अनुरोध है कि (RT-PCR) टैस्ट अपने सामने करवाए।
2. किसी विद्यार्थी को यदि सूखी खोंसी, बुखार या अन्य लक्षण दिखाई दे तो उसे स्कूल में आने की अनुमति नहीं होगी।
3. विद्यार्थियों को निम्नलिखित वस्तुओं के साथ रिपोर्ट करना होगा।
  - क) वॉशेबल कपड़ों के मास्क: 06  
मास्क के बाएँ कोने पर मार्कर से अपना नाम व स्कूल नं० लिखा होना चाहिए।
  - ख) हैंड सेनिटाईजर - 200 मिलि के 02
  - ग) उचित मात्रा में अंडरगारमेंट्स और तौलिए।
  - घ) बड़े रुमाल - 06
  - ङ) आल आउट मशीन (रिफिल के साथ)
4. मोबाईल व इलैक्ट्रॉनिक्स सामान स्कूल परिसर में वर्जित है।
5. विद्यार्थी के स्कूल आने के बाद कोई अवकाश नहीं दिया जाएगा और किताबें, जूते और अन्य सामान खरीदने के लिए भी उसे कोई अवकाश नहीं मिलेगा। विवाह और परिजनों की विमारी पर भी अवकाश नहीं दिया जाएगा।
6. पार्टी और अनावश्यक क्रिया-कलाप भी नहीं होगी।
7. विद्यालय में आने के बाद विद्यार्थी को अपने माता-पिता से मिलने की अनुमति नहीं दी जाएगी।?

8. यदि किसी विद्यार्थी को यहाँ रहते हुए कोरोना पॉजीटिव पाया जाता है तो से तुरन्त सिविल अस्पताल, सोनीपत में ले जाएँगे, और माता-पिता को सूचित करके उसे सौंप दिया जाएगा।
9. यदि परिसर में रहतु हुए विद्यार्थी नियमों का पालन नहीं करता है तो उसे पेरेंट्स के साथ घर भेज दिया जाएगा ताकि अन्य विद्यार्थियों को संक्रमण का खतरा न हो।
10. विद्यालय द्वारा अभिभावको को सहमति पत्र वॉट्सएप एवं स्कूल वैबसाईट के जरिए भेजा जाएगा और अभिभावको को अपने बच्चे के साथ वह सहमति पत्र हस्ताक्षर सहित तथा कोविड रिपोर्ट (प्रिंटेड) लाना होगा।
